



## Moss Hey Primary School Reading and Phonics Scheme

Here at Moss Hey our children enjoy reading and achieve well. We use a range of resources to support their learning, as this allows access to a wide variety of text types. Having a range of books ensures that reluctant readers are inspired by lively and attractive texts, both boys and girls have relevant and interesting material to read, and our high ability readers are challenged.

We teach phonics and reading on a daily basis. In the first few years of school there is a daily phonics session. Throughout the school, focussed guided reading sessions take place on a daily basis. The younger children read on a 1:1 basis to a range of adults throughout the week. Those children who are identified as struggling with their reading have daily sessions. A home/school reading record tracks progress and allows parents to comment on progress.
