Developing our French teaching: We are so lucky to have been successful in winning a British Council bid, to fund language courses for our staff. Each term, two members of staff will be going to Carcassonne for an immersive language course. In March, Mrs Hampson and Mrs Groarke will go as our 'pioneers' in this project, followed by Mr Ramsey and Miss Neal in the summer term. Then two members of staff will go each term for the next four terms. This is an incredibly exciting project and it is a privileged to be part of it. The whole school will gain so much.

**Planning ahead - Choir at the Town Hall:** On Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March, our choir will once again take part in the Town Hall concert. This is always a lovely event and a great experience for the children. We perform three songs as a school and then join with other schools for a joint performance.
