You will be sent clear instructions on how you make your appointment; we will not be able to make appointments for you.

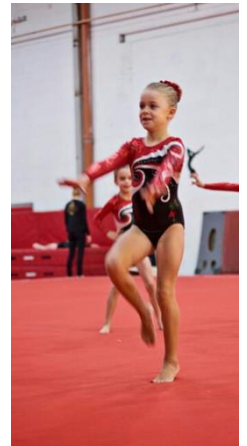
